

what supplies/tools to bring

Electric Kistka (fine, medium and heavy tips)

any tools you would use to maintain and keep your kistka working:
cleaning wire, wax reservoir extender, screw driver (for changing tips –if using an interchangeable kistka), kistka holder.

xacto blade/knife, extra blades

2 fine black ink ballpoint pens. (*I really like to use a zebra 301 but, no need to buy unless you do not have fine tip ballpoint pens*).

color pencil or fine tip markers (*no need to buy new ,bring what you have – one or the other is fine*)

retractable eraser – or white eraser = (*also known as hi-polymer or plastic eraser. I typically just use the retractable kind. These are terrific to remove pencil lines from your egg*).

a sketch book or binder something you can keep your sketches in (*no need to buy please use what you have but size should be at least a 9 x 12 inch , 8 ½ x 11 inch– will be used to keep your egg design sketches in and inspirational notes, design ideas, color combination choices etc*).

magnifying lamp – table top or clamp type or floor type (*again, no need to purchase bring whatever you have and use at home and is easily transportable*).

reading glasses/ – if needed (*maybe an extra/spare pair*)

reusable water bottle - River's Edge is environmentally conscious and does not use plastic water bottles. They request that we use a reusable/refillable water bottle. They will have water, a few other refreshments, tea, coffee, fountain drinks for us to refill and ice will be available.
